

May, 2018 Town Board Meeting Minutes

The May, 2018 Town Board meeting was held on Wednesday, May 2, 2018 at 7:00 PM in the Barneveld-Brigham Municipal Building meeting room in Barneveld Wisconsin.

Board members in attendance were: Chair Jason Carden, Supervisor Kyle T. Thompson and Supervisor Jeff Zander. Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Town Chair Jason Carden. The **Public Notice** was approved on motion by Supervisor Kyle Thompson, seconded by Chair Carden and Carried.

The approval of the **April 4th minutes** was tabled. The **April 9th minutes** were approved on motion by Chair Carden, seconded by Supervisor Thompson and Carried.

The **April 11th minutes** were tabled.

The **2018 Seal Coat bids** were opened. Bids were:

Scott Construction – Total bid \$122,999

Fahrner Asphalt – Total bid \$115,444

Motion made by Chair Carden to accept the bid of Fahrner Asphalt. Town will look at the roads to bring the sealcoat bid price within town budget. Motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson and Carried.

Broadband Recognition: Angie Dickinson and John Dunbar recognized the Town of Brigham as the latest broadband community. A 1.3 million dollar grant was received by MHTC as a result of the Town of Brigham partnering with them on broadband expansion.

Public Comments: None

Chris Handel/Megan VanHecker: Plan Commission Chair Steve Thoni read the motion made by the Plan Commission recommending approval as proposed recognizing they are crossing prime soil. A motion was made by Supervisor Thompson to accept the driveway application off Ceely Road for Chris Handel and Megan

VanHecker, also recognizing the driveway will cross prime soil, but it's disturbing less prime soil than if they following a property line. Motion seconded by Chair Carden and Carried.

David and Joy Coyne: Application requesting to section off 40+ acres and create a new building site and a multi user driveway. It was noted this will involve no prime soil. It was further noted that the driveway must be fixed so that water does not run onto the town road. Motion made by Supervisor Thompson to approve the multi user driveway with the understanding it will meet multi user requirements. Seconded by Chair Carden and carried.

Motion made by Supervisor Thompson to adopt a policy regarding the **procedure for sworn telephone testimony and sworn written testimony for Board of Reviews.** Motion seconded by Chair Carden and Carried.

Motion made by Supervisor Thompson to adopt a **policy regarding the procedure for waiver of Board of Review Hearing Requests.** Motion seconded by Chair Carden and Carried.

Prairie Grove Road Bridge – Weight Limit Restrictions: It was noted that the State of Wisconsin had requested Iowa County lower the weight limit allowed on the Prairie Grove Road Bridge because of new criteria on kinds of loads and the nature of vehicles. Weight is more spread on today's vehicles. It was further noted there may be grant money available to restructure the bridge.

Appointment/Reappointment of Plan Commission Members: On motion by Supervisor Thompson, seconded by Chair Carden – Doug Reeson was re-appointed to the Plan Commission for a 3-year term and Al Feist was appointed to the Plan Commission for a 3-year term. Motion Carried.

At this point, Supervisor Jeff Zander joined the meeting.

Election Voting Machine: Motion made by Supervisor Thompson to purchase the DS200 election machine. Motion seconded by Chair Carden. Motion carried 2-0 with Supervisor Jeff Zander abstaining.

ATC Resolution: Allen Pincus requested the Town Board pass a resolution of opposition to the proposed transmission line. Motion made by Supervisor Zander to adopt Resolution 2018-003 which states the Town of Brigham opposes the proposed Cardinal-Hickory Creek transmission line. Motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson and Carried.

ATV/UTV Wild Life ATV Club: Representing this group, Diane Halverson asked that the Town of Brigham roads be opened up to ATV/UTV Traffic. She noted the enforcement would be done by the DNR and the local police, as well as members of their clubs. Verbally noting support of this request was:

June Town Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 13, 2018 due to absences of 2 board members.

Vouchers: Motion by Supervisor Zander to approve payment of vouchers. Motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson and carried.

Future Agendas: Finalize ATV Ordinance, Talk about a new plow truck and discuss going to a 5-member board.

Adjournment: Motion by Supervisor Thompson to adjourn at 8:55 PM. Motion seconded by Supervisor Zander and Carried.
