

CODIFICATION ORDINANCE
**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE
TOWN OF BRIGHAM, IOWA COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Town Board of the Town of Brigham, Iowa County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION A

The Town Code of Ordinances is hereby adopted and enacted as the "Code of Ordinances of the Town of Brigham, Iowa County, Wisconsin" pursuant to Section 66.0103 of the Wisconsin State Statutes, and shall be treated and considered as a new and original comprehensive Ordinance which shall supersede all other general and permanent Ordinances of the Town passed on or before April 24, 2004 to the extent provided in Section B hereof.

SECTION B

All provisions of the Code shall be in full force and effect from and after April 24, 2004, and all Ordinances of a general and permanent nature of the Town of Brigham, enacted on final passage on or before April 24, 2004, and not included in such Code or recognized and continued in force by reference therein, are hereby repealed from the Code after April 24, 2004, except as hereinafter provided. No Resolution of the Town Board, or action taken by the Town Meeting pursuant to Subchapter III of Wis. Stats. Chap. 60, not specifically mentioned, is hereby repealed.

SECTION C

1 The repeal provided for in Section B hereof shall not affect the following, except that some of the following provisions existing at the time of adoption may be amended by this recodification:

- (a) Any offense or act committed or done or any penalty or forfeiture incurred or any contract or right established or accruing before the effective date of this Ordinance;
- (b) Any Ordinance or Resolution promising or guaranteeing the payment of money for the Town, or any contract or obligations assumed by the Town;
- (c) The administrative Ordinances or Resolutions of the Town not in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of the Code;
- (d) Any appropriation Ordinance or Resolution;
- (e) Any right or franchise granted by the Town Board to any person, firm or corporation;
- (f) Any Ordinance or Resolution dedicating, naming, establishing, locating, relocating, opening, closing, paving, widening, vacating, etc., any street, road or public way in the Town;
- (g) Any Ordinance or Resolution establishing the prescribing of street or road grade of any streets or roads in the Town;

(h) Any Ordinance or Resolution providing for local improvements or assessing taxes or special assessments therefore;

(i) Any Ordinance or Resolution dedicating or accepting any plat or subdivision in the Town;

(j) Any Ordinance or Resolution regulating the erection, alteration, repair, demolition, moving or removal of buildings or other structures, except that these Ordinances have been amended as part of this recodification.

(k) One- and two-family dwelling Building Code; and any other Building Codes except that these Ordinances have been amended as part of this recodification;


2 Nor shall the repeal be construed to revive any Ordinance of part of an Ordinance that has been repealed by a subsequent Ordinance which is repealed by this Ordinance.

SECTION D

A copy of the Code shall be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk, preserved in loose-leaf form, or in such other form as the Town Clerk may consider most expedient. It shall be the express duty of the Town Clerk or someone authorized by the Town Clerk, to insert in their designated places all amendments, Ordinances or Resolutions which indicate the intention of the Town Board to make the same a part of the Code when the same have been printed or reprinted in page form, and to extract from the Code all provisions which may be repealed from time to time by the Town Board. This copy of the Code shall be available for all persons desiring to examine it.


