

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1.05
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHAM
TO ESTABLISH SPLIT SHIFTS FOR ELECTION OFFICIALS

STATE OF WISCONSIN

TOWN OF BRIGHAM

IOWA COUNTY

The Town Board of the Town of Brigham, Iowa County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under 7.30 (1) Wisconsin Statutes, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 (or more) sets of officials to work at different times on election day as follows:

- A. There shall be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 AM and end at 1:30 PM. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 PM and end with completion of all required Election Day duties that follow the closure of the polls.
- B. The Town Board shall for each election appoint an additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 6:30 AM and 1:30 PM and one additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 1:30 PM and 8:00 PM at each polling place in the town. Each additional election inspector shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.

This ordinance is effective upon posting.

The town clerk shall properly post this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
